RE: SDG&E Commitment Letter for CA ARB - Zero Emission Drayage Truck Solicitation

Mr. White:

This letter declares the commitment of San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) to support the application from the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) in partnership with the San Diego Air Pollution Control District and San Diego Port tenants for the California Air Resources Board (CARB) "Zero-Emission Drayage Truck Demonstration Project". The SCAQMD proposal involving a portfolio of electric drive technologies including battery electric trucks and various plug-in hybrid electric vehicles will help SDG&E:

- Learn more about electric charging needs and infrastructure required for Class 8 plug-in drayage trucks,
- Improve the air quality in disadvantaged communities adjacent to the Port of San Diego, and
- Develop recommendations to further the infrastructure standardization efforts for heavy-duty vehicles and to increase SDG&E system asset utilization.

SDG&E's commitment is to provide up to \$200,000 in cash contribution to support charging infrastructure required to fuel the portfolio of electric drive drayage trucks demonstrated by San Diego Port tenants as part of the SCAQMD's application. In addition, SDG&E will provide in-kind support for the project in the form of infrastructure engineering support, and education and outreach. SDG&E's support is contingent on the successful contracting of SCAQMD with CARB related to the Zero Emission Drayage Truck Solicitation and successful contracting of SCAQMD and partners with SDG&E.
