How did SDG&E arrive at an estimated 750,000 Mass TOU Default population? (Chapter 6, page CB-2)?

SDG&E Response to SDGE_ED_09:

The 750,000 Mass TOU Default population provided in A.17-12-013 Chapter 6, page CB-2 was based on the original estimate provided on April 19, 2017, as part of Sabrina Butler's PUC Section 745 Opening Testimony.¹ That number was based on the then-current total residential customer population minus the Mass TOU Default exclusions.

As discussed in response to data request SDGE_ED_01, and as noted in A.17-12-013, CB-3, footnote 3, customer counts are subject to change over time, due to daily fluctuations in customer status.

As of April 2018, the following table provides a calculation of the current Mass TOU Default population.
